Plastering Lath

We produce hand riven lath for traditional lime plastering work. The laths are supplied in bundles of 50 pieces, with a mix of lengths. The irregular surface of the Riven lath gives traditional lime plaster mix a secure surface adhesion. This is the type of lath chosen for most heritage and historic restoration work where authentic traditional materials are required. Please call us for availability.

Carpenters Pegs

These pegs are used in the construction of timber frame buildings to secure joints. The type of peg required varies according to the type of joint. The two different types of peg we can supply are available as follows:

Drawn peg

We've found these to be the preferred peg of the green Oak framer! Especially the 3/4" (18mm). The pegs are cleft Oak, whittled down to produce a gradually tapered, roughly hexagonal peg. These pegs are available in packs of 10 from stock.

NB: The diameter quoted refers to the recommended auger size (size of drilled hole)

Dowel peg

Hand driven through a dye to produce a smooth round cylinder – use where a constant diameter is required. These pegs are available to order.
