

# Round Timber

As part of our broader forestry management activity we organise the felling extraction and transport of both conifer and hardwood timber.

### Hardwood logs

We are interested buyers of English hardwood species for conversion into beam and joinery grade timbers.

We buy standing, at stump or roadside and normal minimum quantity of round timber for selling as a parcel is usually one lorry load. We are however interested to know about individual trees of good dimension and feature.

Standard minimum specifications for hardwood logs

Species	Min Mid Dia cm	Min L m	Comment
Ash	50	2.1	Large diameters preferred
Cedar of Lebanon	39	1.8	Single large trees of real interest
Cherry	32	2.1	Clean, no knots
Elm	45	2.1	Single large trees of real interest
Lime	50	2.1	
Oak	29	2.1	Wide spec, depending on use – parcels only
Plane	60	2.1	Single large trees of real interest
Sweet Chestnut	40	2.1	No shake, clean sound knots acceptable
Sycamore	36	2.1	White, clean winter cut
Walnut	58	2.1	Single large trees of real interest
Yew	40	1.5	No flutes or large knots

Logs are purchased primarily for our own production - see our product pages to see what we do with them.

### Softwood logs

For our own production we purchase good dimension Western red Cedar.

For all other commercial softwoods, Spruce, Larch, Douglas fir, Scots and Corsican Pine we sell to the larger softwood mills on a full load basis. We purchase the timber standing and take responsibility for the felling, extraction and coordination of transport. All timber sold is on an outturn basis.
